



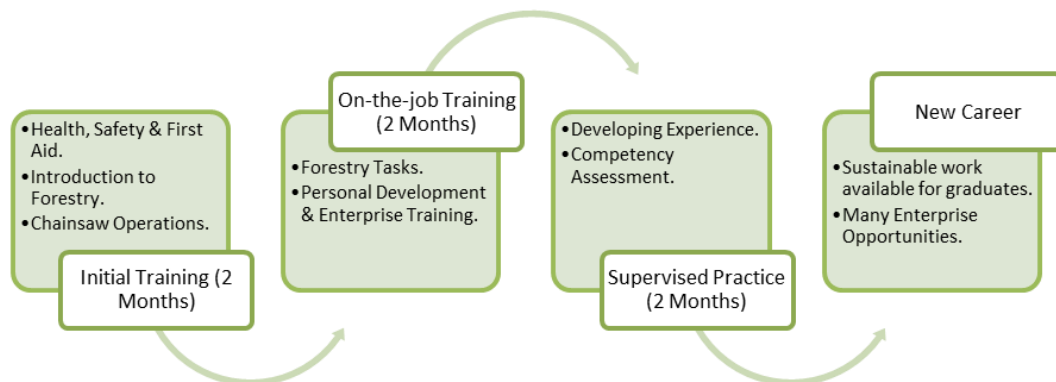

- Candidates with prior farming, construction or sub-contracting experience will have an advantage.
- Must be available to attend training in Glenties and to travel to work-sites throughout Donegal.
